# STAIRCASE MEASURING GUIDE for Straight Stairlifts 

In order to ensure that your AmeriGlide Straight Stairlift installation goes smoothly, it is imperative that proper and accurate measurements* are provided. If you have any questions, or would like some assistance with measuring your staircase, please give us a call at 1-800-790-1635.

## 1. Overall Length

Stand at the top of your stairs, extend your tape measure until it is laying on all the stair treads and the tip of the tape measure is touching the landing at the bottom of the steps. Record this measurement.

## 2. Top Stair to Bottom Stair

While still at the top of the stairs, retract the tape measure until the end of the tape is even with the outer-most portion of the stair nose of the bottom step. Record this measurement.

## 3. Staircase Width

Measure the width of your staircase and enter the measurement.

## 4. Bottom Clearance

If there is a wall or a door at the bottom of the steps, measure from the bottom step to the wall.

## 5. Rise of One Step

Measure from the top of a step to the very next step down.

## 6. Tread Depth

Measure from the front of one step to the front of the kickplate.

## 7. Diagonal

Measure from the front of one step to the front of the next step down.

## 8. Top Clearance

Measure from the top step to the door, wall, or other obstruction at the top of the stairs.
*NOTE: It is IMPERATIVE that the provided measurements are as precise as possible. If the measurements are inaccurate and the rail installation is not possible at your first installation appointment, you may be charged a return service fee, and a new appointment will need to be scheduled.
