- Remove all packaging and debris to leave work area neat and tidy.
- Perform service and repairs as needed.
- Dependable, punctual, and efficient.
- Previous training preferred. Manufacturer training is a plus and will be reflected in compensation. Technical, electrical, and mechanical training is helpful. Some computer skills essential.
- This job is highly physical and requires the ability to carry equipment and walk up and down stairs.
